### Supply List

The following supplies are recommended. All of the following are available at most artists supply stores.

**Paper:** Paper comes in a combination of three characteristics: weight, surface texture and size.

Watercolor Paper or Watercolor Block minimum 12"x16: minimum 140 lb. Cold pressed (I prefer Rough and I order them online through Dick Blick or Jerry's Artarama). Arches paper sold as individual Full Sheets (22" X 30") can be cut in half for the class.

**Recommended Paints:** Tube Watercolors (Winsor Newton, Cotman, Holbein or Grumbacher etc.)

BLUES: Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean

GREENS: Sap Green

YELLOWS: Lemon Yellow, Cadmium Yellow, Yellow Ochre

REDS AND ORANGES: Cadmium Red, Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Orange

BROWNS: Burn Umber, Burnt Sienna, Raw Umber

OTHERS: Payne's Grey, Ivory Black or Lamp Black, Neutral Tint

WHITE: Titanium or Chinese (I prefer titanium)

**Brushes:** Synthetic brushes recommended

Make sure they are watercolor brushes, not oil brushes (WC brushes have short handles)

Round #4 or #6; and a #10 or #12. #2 Rigger (also called Script or Liner)

Optional: #12 or larger Round or #8 Squirrel Mop (also called a Quill Mop)

**Palette:** Watercolor Palette with cover recommended:

#### Miscellaneous:

Water Container: large plastic cups, yogurt or cottage cheese containers work well

Masking Tape

Pencil and Eraser

Drawing board: ¼" Plywood, Masonite, Gator Foam or any stiff board / Size 12"x16" minimum, 16"x24" or larger preferred

Spray Bottle

Napkins, tissues or wash rag

Hair Dryer for those impatient people like me.
